## Directions for use

Livestock should be given good quality hay prior to starting on the pellets. Gradually introduce pellets with the hay over a 7 day period. Increase the pellets gradually, decreasing the hay to allow stock to adjust to the pellet. Hay can then be removed and pellets fed. Typical feeding rates can vary. Seek advice from a qualified livestock nutritionist.

When fed a pellet only diet, stock will consume approximately 3.5% of their bodyweight each day. For a 60kg ewe, this means a daily intake of around 2kg. The actual amount you need to feed depends on:

- The class of stock (age/pregnant/lactating etc)
- The current condition of the stock
- Target condition of the stock
- Availability of other feed sources.

Pellets can be trail fed, fed in troughs or feeders.

Ensure there is always clean water available daily.

The pellets are recommended to be used within 6 months of the date of manufacture.
